Are You Eligible?

In order to submit an entry you must be at least 18 years of age or older. The person you nominate must live, work, or play within a 50 mile radius of downtown Asheville, NC. The nominee must also be a rising high school senior (they will be a senior in the fall semester of 2010).

Don’t Forget the Rules

Each participant must meet the guidelines for eligibility as stated above. Only one entry allowed per person. Entries must be submitted no later than midnight on April 21, 2010. Any entries received after the deadline will not be considered. Entries must follow the guidelines for submission in order to be considered.
